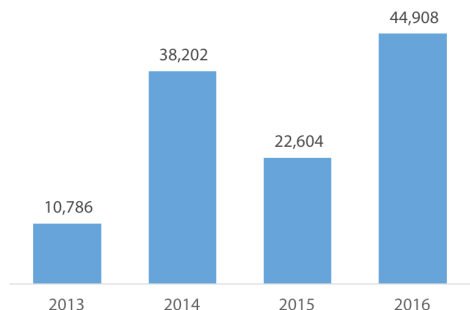

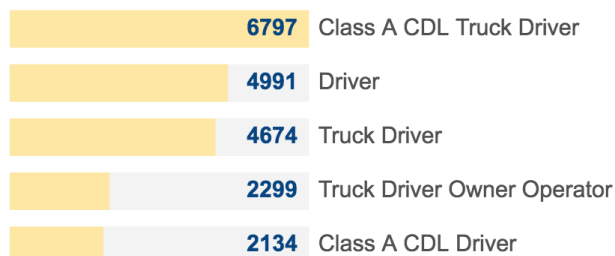

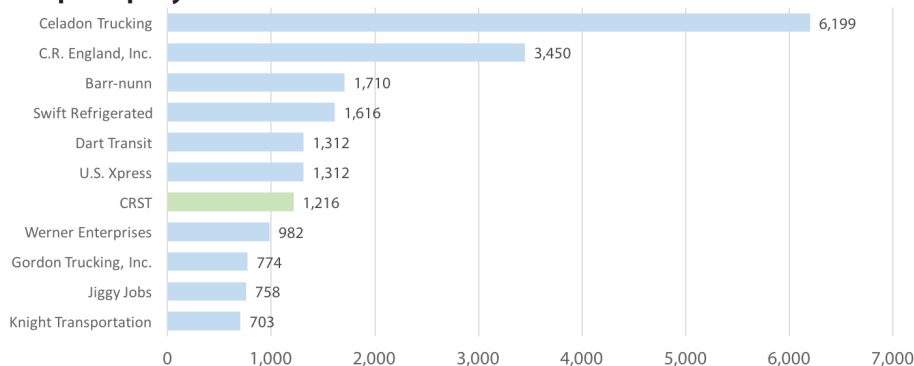
Top Occupations

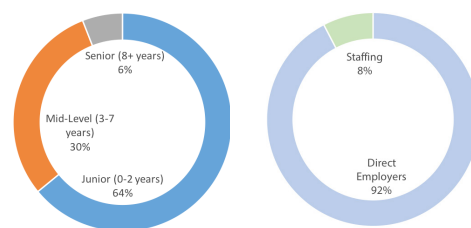
