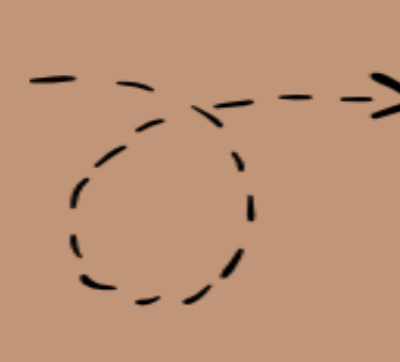


Hispanics/Latinos are in the workforce

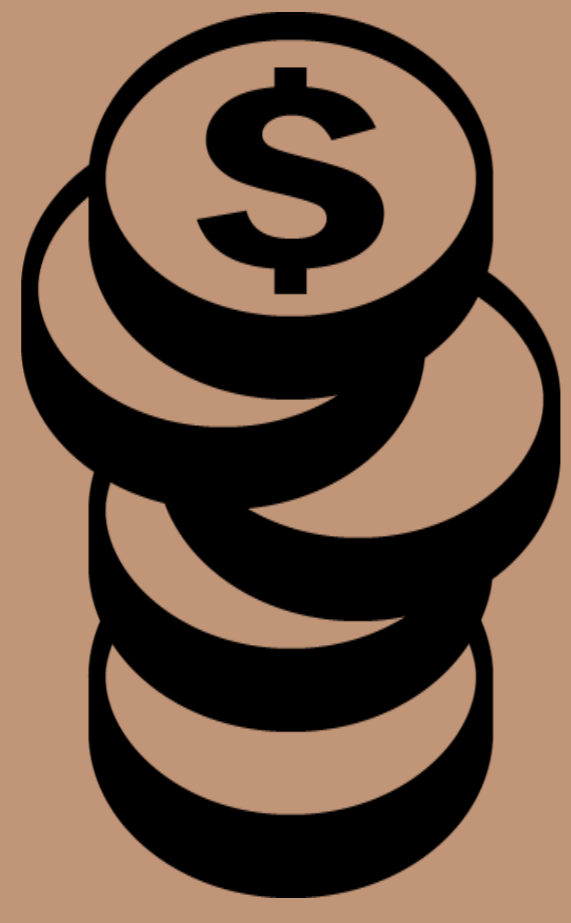
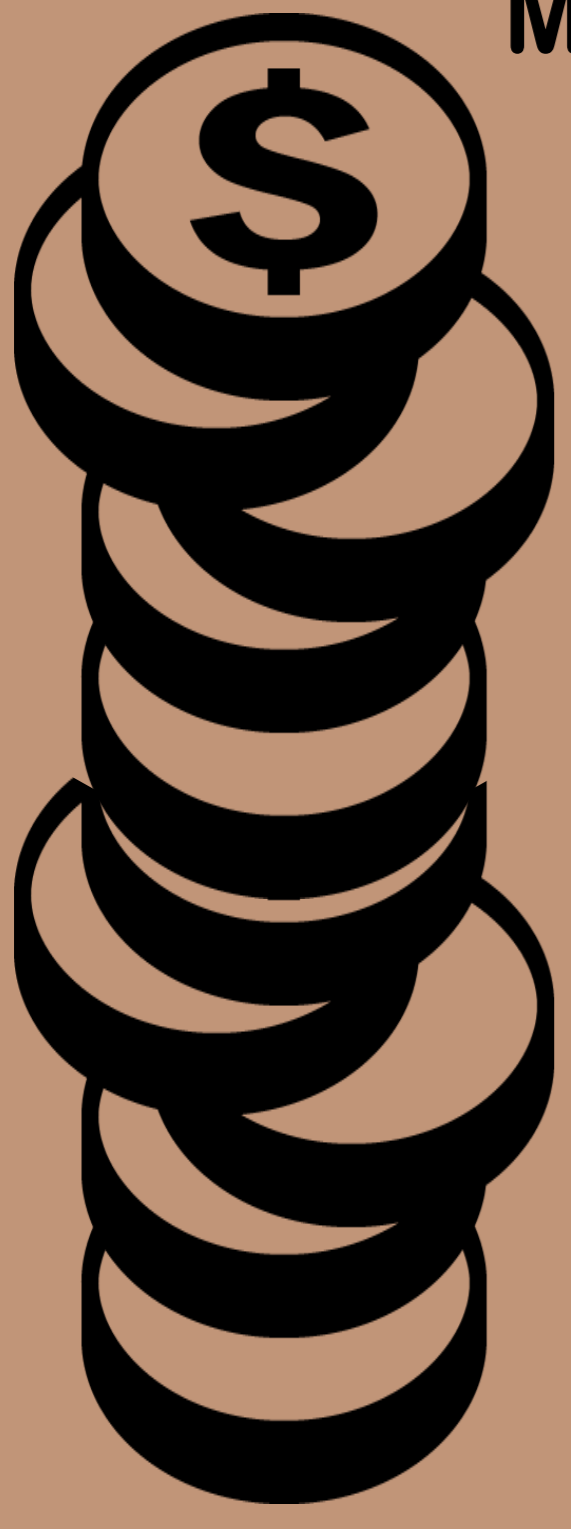
